

19th AZK: "Corona: No reconciliation without settling accounts" (Ralf Ludwig)

After drastic Corona measures with devastating consequences for the population, politics and media are campaigning for reconciliation and understanding. Lawyer Ralf Ludwig clearly shows in his talk why there can be no reconciliation without settling accounts!

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Short Biography:

Ralf Ludwig was born in Osterode near Harz in Lower Saxony, Germany in 1972. He is a lawyer specializing in social, administrative and constitutional law. Since the Corona crisis he has worked in the area of criminal and misdemeanor law.

The basis for his work as a lawyer can be read on the website of his law firm: "He who accepts evil without protesting against it is really cooperating with it." (Civil Rights Campaigner Martin Luther King)

At the beginning of the Corona Pandemic, Ralf Ludwig achieved, via the Federal Constitutional Court, that protest rallies are not allowed to be generally prohibited during times of crisis. He prevailed in the administrative courts, ensuring that the big (Querdenker) Rally against the Covid measures, on August 29th, 2020 at the Victory Column in Berlin could take place. He was part of the Defender Team for Michael Ballweg during his time of arrest. In June 2021, due to the Corona measures, he founded the Center for the Investigation, Clarification, Legal Prosecution and Prevention of Crimes against Humanity (ZAAVV).

Today Ralf Ludwig will speak on the topic: "Corona: No reconciliation without settling accounts".
