

STOP - no vaccination experiments on children and adolescents!

VACCINATIONS ARE PART OF OUR MEDICAL PRECAUTIONS, BUT:
WE STRONGLY WARN AGAINST MASS COVID-19-VACCINATIONS IN CHILDREN AND ADOLESCENTS! THEREFORE:

CHILDREN ARE SIGNIFICANTLY LESS AT RISK BY COVID-19 THAN ADULTS

Children rarely develop severe COVID-19, and even more rarely die from it. Evidence-based they are not at risk for more severe courses of COVID-19. Only a very few individual children would benefit from mass vaccination - but millions of them bear the risks.

CHILDREN DO NOT PLAY A SIGNIFICANT ROLE IN SPREADING COVID-19

This also applies to the already minimal risk of transmission in schools and daycare centers - which even the Robert Koch Institute confirms. Mass vaccination of children and adolescents can therefore not significantly reduce the further spread of COVID-19. Schools and daycare centers can and must be reopened even without child vaccination.

VACCINATING CHILDREN WILL NOT PROMOTE HERD IMMUNITY

At this point in time, it is completely unclear whether COVID-19-vaccines can contribute at all to sustainable herd immunity. Even the most optimistic studies admit that vaccination does not even reduce by half the risk of infecting others - too little to induce herd immunity through vaccination. In addition, we currently do not know how long a vaccination immunity lasts at all. We also do not know against which mutations of SARS-CoV-2 the current vaccinations would reliably protect.

CHILDREN ARE PARTICULARLY AT RISK FROM THE SIDE EFFECTS OF VACCINES

In all previous studies of COVID-19-vaccines, the severe and most serious side effects affected were mainly in younger people. Medium- and long-term vaccine consequences cannot be evaluated at present, but there is a particularly serious risk for children and adolescents. The vaccine trials that have been started up to now with children and adolescents are far too small, and furthermore their observation period is far too short to meet the particularly high requirements for vaccine safety with children and adolescents.
